### **LEGISLATIVE TURN AROUND MARKS HALF WAY POINT OF SESSION**

The Legislature reached its first major deadline of the last day to consider Non-Exempt Bills in the House of Origin, commonly referred to as “turn-around”. The House and Senate both adjourned Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>.

The Legislative Deadlines have been revised since the session began. The new deadlines have moved the various dates up by a few days. The official date of the regular session is now April 6<sup>th</sup>, which is four days earlier than the original deadline. The legislature is expected, however, to adjourn the regular session On Friday April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

The legislature continues to grind through the tough budget issues it is facing. The current projected shortfall for next fiscal year, FY 2011, is approximately \$430 million. That amount is expected to grow over the coming months as the monthly revenues the state receives are expected to continue to be below estimates. The budget writing committees have been working on their respective budgets and it is uncertain at this time whether the traditional first budget bill, known as the “mega” budget, will be approved before the first adjournment at the beginning of April.

The discussion of how to balance the budget also continues. The House Taxation Committee has held several hearings on tax proposals. The bill that had the most attention would repeal numerous sales tax exemptions. Some of the exemptions the bill, [HB 2549](#), proposed to repeal included many non-profit exemptions, the exemption on utilities for private use, and many others. The committee has not worked the bill at this time, but is expected to take action the week of March 1<sup>st</sup>.



The Senate Assessment & Taxation Committee has not held hearings on the proposals at this time, opting to wait to see what action the House takes on the proposals. The Senate tax Committee Chairman, Les Donovan, R-Wichita, is expected to schedule hearings on [SB 476](#), which is identical to [HB 2549](#), in the next couple weeks.

It does not appear at this point, that the legislature will balance the budget with just cuts. Some kind of tax proposal is expected to be needed to balance the books for next year. The sales tax exemption repealer bills are not expected to pass at this time, with the vigorous defense of the various exemptions the organizations that receive the exemptions are putting up. What the final tax package looks like is still very uncertain and likely won't be decided until the wrap-up session during May.

## Water Bills Receive Attention

Several bills dealing with water issues have received serious discussion.

[HB 2283](#), a bill that has been in conference committee since last session, had the provisions agreed to by the conference committee this week. As the bill passed the Senate, it would enact new law dealing with the process of transfer of water service when a city annexes property where a rural water district is providing service and amend existing law to provide additional factors that must be considered by a rural water district's board of directors prior to their releasing lands from the rural water district. The bill also would repeal current law dealing with the annexation of lands located within water districts and clarify existing guidelines for the implementation of an intensive groundwater use control area (IGUCA) within the boundaries of a groundwater management district.

The conference committee kept most of the provisions but took out the IGUCA provisions and made modifications to the rural water district language. The conference committee report is expected to be voted on next week.

[Senate Bill 510](#) would establish "conservation use" as a new and distinct beneficial use of water under the Kansas Water Appropriation Act. The Senate Committee on Natural Resources conducted a hearing on the bill last week. Kansas Department of Agriculture, Kansas Livestock Association, Kansas Farm Bureau, and groundwater management districts were among those who testified in favor of the bill, although the stakeholder groups wanted additional language to address specific issues. The conferees are working on amended language. The bill is exempt from the "turnaround" deadline since it was referred from Senate Ways and Means.

[HB 2565/H. Sub. For SB 316](#) was considered by the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources last week and passed alternate language placed in House Substitute for Senate Bill 316. The new language would amend K.S.A. 82a-718 to establish that "...a groundwater right, which has as its local supply an aquifer area that has been closed to new appropriations by rule, regulation or order of the chief engineer and where means of diversion are available to put water to a beneficial use within a reasonable time, shall be deemed to have due and sufficient cause for nonuse and shall not be deemed abandoned." The bill is similar to SB 510 above.
